We are investigating the possibility of getting a speed bump and cross walk to help facilitate with traffic.

*The HLA Board Of Directors has agreed to match all fundraising proceeds and donations, dollar for dollar, up to \$10,000.00 towards our playground. We are trying to minimize our fundraising activities this year, while still maximizing our fundraising proceeds in order to get the playground purchased and installed this coming summer. More details regarding fundraisers will be coming home soon, as will final details on the purchase price of the playground and the amount still needed to purchase and install it.

*If your children have been participating in the Morning Mile program and have walked or run the equivalent of 10 miles (100 circuits around our track), they will be receiving a Morning Mile charm for each 10 miles they have walked. We are sending home these charms with report cards. We will be having a Morning Mile celebration and our first tour in the near future. We will notify you of the date soon.

*We have sent home certificates for those children who have achieved honor roll status for the first nine weeks. HLA honor roll recognizes all students who have received straight A’s or E’s on their report cards. Congratulations to those students!

***Please remember that school begins promptly at 7:45 a.m.** Please have your child here by 7:40 to ensure they have time to check in and unpack before Morning Meeting begins at 7:45. Doors open at 7:15 a.m., and Morning Mile starts as soon as we have two parent volunteers here to help.
