**\*\*\*\*** *Spelling Homework* - I am going to ask for your help in a couple of areas in which some students are experiencing difficulties. Please check your children's spelling homework when he or she has completed it for the following items.

<u>1.</u> <u>Spelling of words correctly-</u> If they are spelling them wrong during practice, they will most likely spell them wrong for the test.

2. Signing and returning important documents. It is imperative that any documents that come home are signed and returned in a timely manner. I want to make sure that the school to home communication is clean and concise. As always, if you have any further questions please feel free to ask!
3. Marking and dividing words correctly- It is extremely important that your children understand the rules I am teaching each week! If you are not sure about a rule, please ask and I'll be happy to explain. On the weekends, I would like the children to mark their flashcards. They should be written with room between the words to show the marks and divisions. Your children have been doing this in the classroom, they should understand what this means, and be able to apply it at home.

\*\*\*\*\***Reminder-** PARENTS ! **PLEASE be sure to write your children's names in their jackets, sweatshirts, etc.** We have acquired quite a few lovely jackets and sweaters that need a nice home again. <sup>©</sup> If you could help us check to make sure your children have all of their jackets, sweatshirts, lunchboxes, water bottles, etc when you pick them up that would be a great help!

\*\*\*\*\*\*Tip of the week- Handwashing is a do-it-yourself vaccine. The CDC recommends scrubbing your hands with soap for 20 seconds. It should take about 30 seconds to scrub (up the wrists, between the fingers, and under the nails) and rinse. Talk to your child about healthy handwashing habits at home to reinforce the skills he or she is learning in school.
