Reading Logs – Weekly reading logs are on the bring back side of the purple home folder (where they should stay). They are due each Monday, with one summary written on the back, or typed. Don't forget, this is part of your children's reading grade!! Please help your children keep up with this. (We will start with at least 4 sentences for our summaries, this will slowly increase as the year progresses.)

Math Homework- Each night, the math homework will be a review of that day's concept. This is a follow up to what I have taught in class that day and your children should be able to complete this on their own. Your children are required to complete half of the math homework page, but may complete the entire page for additional Reward Cash. **This page needs to be returned the next day.** Additionally, it is imperative at this point that your children practice their basic math facts (addition and subtraction.) The best way to increase your children's knowledge and speed is to use flashcards with them on a nightly basis.

Spelling Homework- Please consult the Spelling Menu for a weekly description of what needs to be done for Spelling homework. For the weekend homework we will be writing our spelling words on index cards, please do not mark the cards. We mark the cards as a class first thing on Monday.

Tip of the Week – Show responsibility (You can do this by having your children take responsibility for their homework and helping to get their routines set for the new school year (getting ready in the morning, making snack/lunch, bedtime routines, etc.)
