<p>1 point <b><u>ABC Order</u></b> Write out your spelling words and then write them in alphabetical order</p>	<p>1 point <b><u>Rhyme Time</u></b> Write your spelling words with a rhyming word next to them.</p>	<p>1 point <b><u>Backwards Words</u></b> Write your words, then rewrite them in backwards order Ex: cat, tac</p>
<p>2 points <b><u>3 Times Each</u></b> Write each word 3 times carefully, focusing on handwriting</p>	<p>2 points <b><u>Bubble Letter Words</u></b> Write each spelling word using bubble letters. When finished color in and decorate each word.</p>	<p>2 points <b><u>In Your Own Words</u></b> Write the spelling word along with your own explanation of the word.</p>
<p>3 points <b><u>Make Your Own</u></b> Create an activity! Practice your spelling words your own way. Be sure to explain what you did.</p>	<p>3 points <b><u>Word Search Words</u></b> Make a word search on graph paper using all of your spelling words. Don't forget to write a list of the words to be searched for.</p>	<p>3 points <b><u>Spelling Practice Test</u></b> Have an adult quiz you on the week's words. Correctly write any misspelled words. An adult must sign your paper.</p>
<p>4 points <b><u>Word Drawing</u></b> Draw a picture for each of your words. When you hear this word, what do you think of?</p>	<p>4 points <b><u>Story Words</u></b> Write a short story on a topic of your choice. Include all of your spelling words in the story, be sure to underline the words.</p>	<p>4 points <b><u>Sentences</u></b> Use each word in a meaningful sentence. Be sure to underline or highlight the spelling words.</p>
<p>5 points <b><u>Number Words</u></b> Write out your spelling words and then find the value of each of your words. (a= 1 b= 2, etc.) Ex: spelling= 94</p>	<p>5 points <b><u>Define It!</u></b> Use the dictionary to find and define each word.</p>	<p>5 points <b><u>Crossword Spelling</u></b> Write word clues and then make a crossword puzzle on graph paper using all of your words.</p>
