-Writing Focus- We have recently begun more extensive writing practice in class. We are working towards writing essays with three paragraphs. Each student has a rubric for our writings that they should keep in their purple folders. On the back of these rubrics is a reminder and example graphic organizer on how

to write a paragraph that flows. (Hamburger paragraphs) With this in mind we are also trying to build paragraphs with five complete sentences. I would greatly appreciate if you try to have your child use these resources while they are writing their summaries.

- Parent volunteers opportunity- Some parent volunteers are needed to listen to the students read. We have only had a couple parents come in this year and have the children read to them. Reading out loud is such an important skill for the children to have in every grade. I realize life is busy, and there is not much time for the children to read out loud at home, but this is a GREAT opportunity for the students to get the chance to read to an adult.
