#### **Classroom News**

This week in class we wrapped up the beginning of the year testing and will start a regular classroom schedule next week. The kids did a fabulous job giving me their best on these tests!

Homework! Students start a regular schedule of weekly homework consisting of math, reading, & spelling. Details are enclosed!

A reading log is attached & a new one will be sent home every Friday. Students are required to read to you 5-7 minutes 3 days a week (even though the reading log has 5 days on it). It is due every Friday. This should give plenty of flexibility with extra curricular activities. Please make sure your child is reading a book that is on his/her level. If he/she misses more than 3 words on any given page, it is too hard for them. Reading homework will be increased every few weeks. Please have your child fill out his/her reading log with their name & title of the book read. Parents will indicate how many minutes your child read & initial it daily. Each day read is worth 33%. 10% will be deducted for late assignments unless accompanied by an excused absence.

# **Wow! Significance**

**Spelling Words** Students will receive their spelling words in class today. They will write each word on an index card. The index cards should be located in their pencil pouches. The purpose of the index cards are so we can 'mark up' the words (phonics) together each Monday. We are going to start out with only 5 spelling words for several weeks. The amount of spelling words will be increased to 7 & then eventually to 10

per week. There will also be 2 bonus words on each spelling test that follow the phonics pattern. **Spelling tests are every** Friday. Please see the attached paperwork for detailed spelling homework instructions & an acknowledgement to sign & return. I have also attached homework samples.
