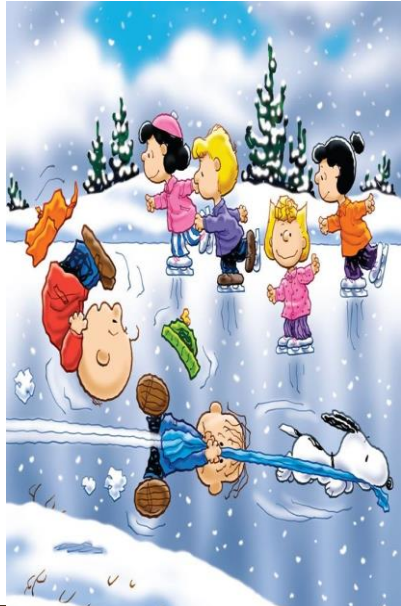


What's Going On?
