Math Studies

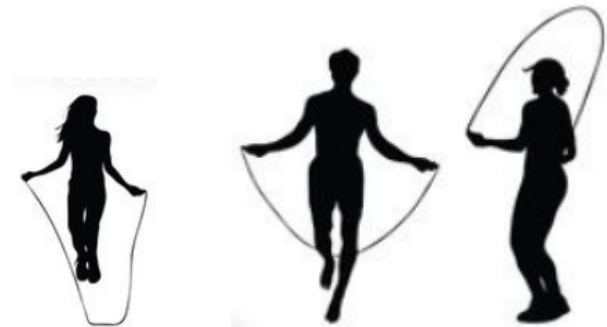
