## **Old Business**

## **New Business items**

- **Board Liaison Report**-Ms. Katje reported two letters to read. These are recommendations for Mr Weissler's submission for principal. <u>Letters to be appended.</u>
- **Budgeting work.** HLA is using best information from district in constructing budget. Current state level expectations are that enrollment reductions will drive district level shortfalls, but that HLA will not experience a strong change in budget because enrollment is at maximum and there is a large waiting list for the school, so only changes to FTE would affect HLA.
- **Personnel:** updates this (coming) year to personnel for HLA.
  - New Principal as noted (interviews happening). Personnel choices that are not immediately pressing will defer to new principal.
  - o New counselor.
  - New guardian.
  - New teachers for 5<sup>th</sup> grade.
- **Employee Salary Proposals** are presented based on available budget. <u>BOD proposed to comnfirm teacher salaries as per tentative</u>. Whitney moved, Sharon seconded all approved.
- Principal's Report:
  - Enrollment is projected at capacity for 2025-26.
  - One student was permanently dismissed for specific handbook violations, which were repeat incidents, an action not taken lightly and coordinated with district security.
